# **Spotters**

Certified Amateur Operators
 Registered Spotters
 Capable of 2m communication to Winnipeg

>150 Spotters in >40 communities (Southern Manitoba)
No Spotters in South-West Manitoba
Ensure that affected area has Spotters before activating net or calling District reps – if we don't have coverage in an area tell the Severe Wx Forecaster!

#### Activation

Can be any of: Severe Weather Forecaster PASPC On-Call CANWARN Net Controller CANWARN District Representative Seasonal Activations: 2010 11 Nets 2009 7 Nets 2008 8 Nets early JUN to Early AUG 2007 **15 Nets**: 2 in May, 8 in June\*, 2 in July \* Including F-5 Tornado in Elie 2006 18 Nets: 1 in MAY, 6 in JUN, 6 in JUL, 5 in AUG 2005 6 Nets: 2 in JUN, 4 in JUL

#### Activation con't

Manitoba CANWARN Program unique:
Net Controller or District rep can cause activation in addition to Severe Wx Forecaster
Only circumstance associated with ARES where "self-activation" is allowed (we don't need the served agency to make the request)
DAY Net Controller to phone Severe Wx Forecaster daily at 1100h to enquire about possible activations (unlisted 983-xxxx)

# Net Operation

Closed, directed 2m Net VE4WWO is Net Control Station Spotters educated to give call-signs phonetically, with location initially NCS May or may not call for check-ins (depends on Alert condition & NCS judgment) ARES Net Controller on call 0930-2130h daily week before Victoria Day to week after Labor Day PASPC staff to contact WPGARES Duty Coordinator when no Net Controller On-Call

# Net Operation con't

Loss of communications:

- Some districts have local plan, or
- Spotters can report by phone using number circulated at Spotter Training session
- During VHF Net, Controller should monitor HF if possible:
  - 40 m 7.070 MHz LSB Day
  - 80m 3.760 MHz LSB Eve

# **CANWARN** Controllers

On-Call Controller has numeric pager, parking pass & Net Control Manual, +/- Access Card\*
 34 weeks on-call (17 wks DAYs, 17 wks EVE)
 Net controllers must be ARES members

 Display ARES photo ID when on duty at VE4WWO
 DON'T turn the pagers off except to replace batteries!

\* Access Card issuing mechanism not quite ready as of 16 MAY


#### 4<sup>th</sup> floor Union Station 123 Main Street



#### VE4WWO Con't

Sign in and out at Security Desk when attending EVE & Week-ends (located in south-east corner of rotunda) Show location attending as **PASPC** 

If no Access Card, must phone unlisted 983 number to have someone from Wx Centre come down to let you in.



# **PASPC** Parking

Approximately 5 parking spots in North Lot at Union Station, centre row, stalls:

137, 138, 139, 140, 141 AND # 119

Marked "Reserved 24 Hrs Tow Away Enforced PASPC" **DISPLAY PARKING PASS** 



# **VE4WWO Equipment**

VHF & HF Station:

TM-261, DCI Filter & PS to 1/4 Wave Omni

♦ FT-1500, DCI Filter, PS & Ant Switch to:

- Single Bay Omni on the roof
- 3 element beam pointing at CDN
- Leave Antenna Switch at GND when closing station

IC-718 & PS to Dipole on roof





#### MFJ-948 Versa Tuner

Belongs to Kent VE4KEH, not Environment Canada
SOP in Controller Manual

Select appropriate memory
Decrease RF power to 20 Watts
Use AM mode to send a carrier
Follow SOP



#### **Station Resources**

User Manuals for all radios (TM-261A, FT-1500, IC-718) Station Logbook (Black colored bound book) Severe Weather Event Log binder Blue Duotang with list of Spotter by district with phone numbers (to be updated MAY 2011) Green Duotang with WWO Updates Sherlock Streetquide Manitoba Highway Map VE4 Blue Book Net Controller Manual

# Station Log

Please log station open & close date/time Reason for activation (e.g Tornado Warning for Wpg) & Repeaters Utilized **Operators on/off duty** Significant Wx reports received Equipment problems, changes, repairs, testing, etc Station Visits (practice, tests, demo, etc)



#### Phone Calls from within PASPC

For long distance calls: Dial 1-204-xxx-xxxx (**don't** dial "9" first) For local calls: Dial "9" first, eg 9-xxx-xxxx

Select "Media" line or a misc line **NOT** "Severe WX" Line or "Reporting" Line

# **Once Activated**

Attend PASPC in timely fashion If possible notify appropriate district rep early Park in correct location if using North Lot Display parking pass Sign-in if Eve or Week-end Access card to get thru main floor door & main door on 4<sup>th</sup> floor, otherwise will have to phone Wx Centre for access Numeric code door to access Wx Centre

Get current Watch or Warning bulletin from Forecaster or Summer student Importance of Reviewing Written Watch/Warning

Tornado Watches
1. Funnel Cloud Watch
Funnel clouds or weak tornados

2. Landspout Watch

From weak thunderstorms, can cause up to F1 damage

3. Supercell Tornado Watch

# Once Activated con't

- Notify appropriate District Rep if you haven't already done so
- Turn on the radios, select appropriate freqs, monitor briefly & start the CANWARN Net using appropriate Net Script (log station opening & reason)
- Depending on what's happening you might need to be listening to **both** VHF radios
- If too much going on get help:
  - Call another Net Controller
  - Poll on WPG for an available Net Controller or ARES member
  - Page WPGARES Duty Coordinator

#### Pinawa District

 Pinawa Coordinator previously requested notice when wx is at least 30-40 miles out so that mobile Spotters can safely get onto the air and into place

#### If Advice Required while at PASPC

On't ask for advice on the air!

Page WPGARES Duty Coordinator Or try phoning Kent VE4KEH or Glen VE4GWN

**Don't** reprogram any radios without speaking with Duty Coordinator or Kent VE4KEH. Notify MBQ via e-mail if any radios reprogrammed.

#### **Need Practice?**

On-Call Controllers can attend WWO anytime for proficiency practice

- On-call Controllers encouraged to attend WWO at least once/week so Wx Centre staff get to know them
  - Consider operating WWO during MMWX Net or MEPN

Not on call & want access:

- Try to arrange thru on-call Controller
  - Or phone James Cummine
  - Or phone Natalie Hasell


#### **Alert Conditions**

# Yellow Alert

Severe Weather Warning or Tornado Watch No check-ins, only stations with reports of: ♦ Hail Damaging Winds Wall Clouds Funnel Clouds Tornados Unusual Wx Events Strange cloud formations Roll clouds

# **Red Alert**

**Tornado Warning** 

No check-ins, only reports of:
Wall Clouds
Funnel Clouds
Tornados
Local ARES group should be on alert
(Local EC/AEC decision, NOT CANWARN Net Controller decision)

#### Summer Reports

Summer reports should focus on: Any tornadic event or funnel cloud Rotating wall cloud Shelf Cloud Any Hail  $\diamond$  Winds > 90 Km/h Rain > 50 mm/h or > 75 mm 2-3 hrsVisibility reduced to less than ½ Km Spotters report by telephone if no Net in progress

#### Summer Reports con't

PASPC Severe Wx Event Log used to record all incoming reports (CANWARN, Media, Wx Watchers, etc)

Record appropriate info & pass completed report to Severe Wx Forecaster (or summer student)

If completed report is returned to WWO desk file in back of Severe Weather Event Log binder

If going thru into EVE ensure that EVE Controller is paged well before 1730h so they will know to attend PASPC (and maybe just stay downtown instead of going home to the "burbs" just to come back)

Log time station closed

Sign-out at Security Desk if you signed in

# Unable to Cover a Day?

- Controllers can trade weeks and days if mutually convenient, notify MBQ for trades > 1 day
- Several Controllers might be able to provide short-notice 1 or 2 day relief:

  - John VE4JNF
  - Dick VE4HK
  - Ed VE4EIH
  - Bob VE4RCJ

# Summary

VHF Operation with HF back-up. 3 Activation scenarios. **On-call Net Controller for VE4WWO** avail 12 h daily Victoria Day to Labor Day. 3 Alert Conditions, don't always ask for checkins. Spotters report by telephone if no Net Net Controllers should feel free to attend WWO for proficiency practice.

#### "Do"

Phone Wx Centre daily at 1100h if on-call 983-xxxx (unlisted, see Wx Centre # DAYs on roster, page 20 in Net Controller Manual) Park in appropriate spot with pass displayed Always display ARES photo-ID card Record station activities in Station Log Try to attend WWO at least 1/wk if on-call Record Spotter Reports on PASPC Severe Weather Log Sheet & pass on to Forecasters Notify EVE Controller if DAY Net will be going past 1700h

#### "Don't"

Turn pagers off during the season Use manual tuner if uncertain Ask for advice on the air But ask for discrete advice if you need to But do get help if you need it Take check-ins during Alert Yellow or Red Do take specific reports accordingly Reprogram radios with consultation & notification
